RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the charter for the City of Kings Mountain as amended provides for the Bi-Annual Election for the Mayor, Board of Commissioners, and members of the Kings Mountain School District is to be held on the second Tuesday after the first Monday in May, 1969, AND WHEREAS, it is the duty of this Board of Commissioners to call said election, And whereas, the election of the Mayor and Board of Commissioners for the City of Kings Mountain, and trustees for the Kings Mountain School District is to be held on the second Tuesday after the first Monday, this date being May 13, 1969 pursuant to the provisions of the city municipal elections law as amended thereto,

And whereas, it is incumbent upon the Board of Commissioners for the City of Kings Mountain to issue notice of said election,

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Board of Commissioners for the City of Kings Mountain that notice of election reading as follows shall be published in a newspaper published in the City of Kings Mountain for four successive weeks prior thereto:

NOTICE OF ELECTION

Pursuant to provisions of the Charter for the City of Kings Mountain and of the state laws relative to the conduct of municipal elections, and to a resolution adopted by the Board of Commissioners on March 11, 1969, an election is ordered to be held on the second Tuesday after the first Monday in May, this date being May 13, 1969 for the election of a Mayor, six members of the Board of Commissioners for the City of Kings Mountain, one each to be elected from each ward and for the election of two trustees for the Kings Mountain School District. These trustees shall reside within the corporate limits.

THE VOTING PLACES SHALL BE AS FOLLOWS:

- Ward No. 1—City Hall
- Ward No. 2—The American Legion Building
- Ward No. 3—East School
- Ward No. 4—First Wesleyan Methodist Fellowship Hall
- Ward No. 5—National Guard Armory
- Ward No. 6—Kings Mountain High School

The Registration Books will be opened at the aforesaid voting places for four (4) successive Saturdays next preceding the election, beginning on Saturday April 12, 1969 between the hours of 9:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M. for the registration of persons eligible to vote in said election, and the registration books will be opened for public inspection and challenge on Saturday, May 10, 1969.

That on Monday, May 12, 1969, the Registrars and Judges in any ward or school district where there may be a challenge shall sit, at an hour convenient to themselves, for the purpose of deciding whether or not the challenge shall stand or be dismissed.

The polls shall be opened at 6:30 A.M. and held open until 6:30 P.M. local time, Tuesday, May 13, 1969.

That the registrars and judges shall conduct the election and certify the results of same to the board of commissioners for the City of Kings Mountain in accordance with the law.

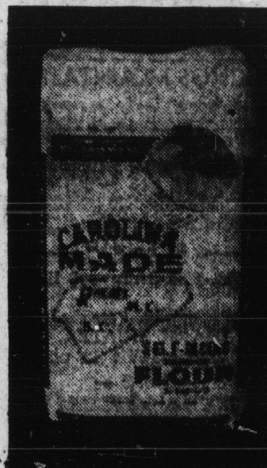

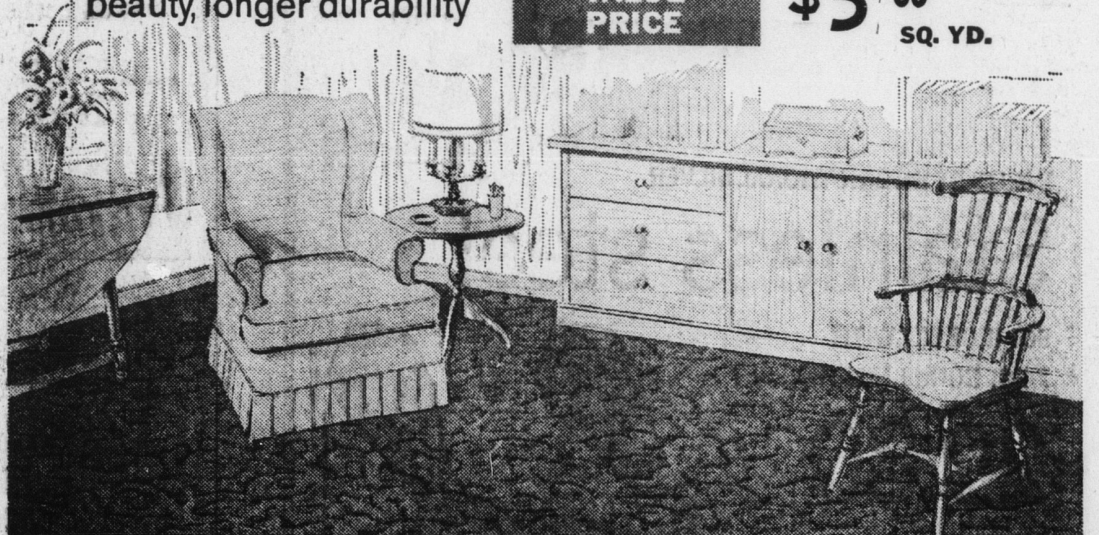
