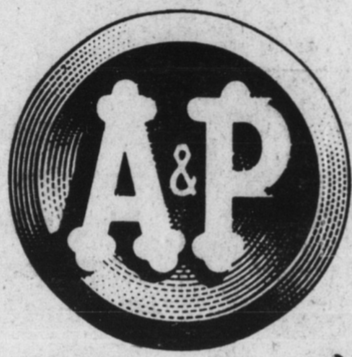

New Sewing Aid On Market

RALEIGH — One of the new sewing aids on the market looks like a thin spider web that's almost invisible. But it can hold two layers of fabric together without stitching, says Dorothy Barrier, extension clothing specialist, North Carolina State University.

When you buy the new "web" material, it's stuck on brown paper. You apply it to one piece of fabric with a dry iron, remove the paper, then fuse the two pieces of fabric together with steam. It's claimed not to change the look or feel of the fabric itself, just give it stability and shape.

The "web" has no grainline, so you don't have to worry about direction when cutting it out. Manufacturers say it's washable and drycleanable. It's invisible when fused so color matching is not a problem. But test a web material on a piece of your fabric before you decide where you will use it, Miss Barrier cautions.

The bonding is done with steam fusing hems in place, holding facings down and giving stability to collars. Try it for setting appliques and trimmings or a patch to mend holes and tears.

If you make a mistake the directions say to unbind the fabrics by steaming and pulling the layers apart while warm.

It will melt on your iron surface if you touch the iron to the web while it's on the paper or fabric. But it's easy to remove by wiping it off with a damp cloth while the iron's still warm.

The fusible web is a fairly new product so some fabric out-

lets may not stock it yet. In fact, it is still in the test-market stage. However, if it's available in your area be sure to ask for special instructions on just how to use it. The web is 20 inches wide. It might save you some stitching, and you can be among the first to experiment with "press together" sewing.
