Egg Dip Is Favorite Of 4-H'ers

In celebration of North Carolina Egg Month, local and county 4-H'ers participated in a project sponsored by the Cleveland County 4-H Council.

The 4-H'ers served a dip recipe, "Smoked North Carolina Egg Dip", in local grocery stores Friday afternoon. They report the dip is delicious with radish slices and served with crackers potato chips or melba toast.

This recipe makes one quart.

12 hard-cooked eggs iced or sieved

2 tablespoons soft butter or margarine

1 1/2 teaspoons liquid smoke seasoning

1 tablespoon lemon juice or vinegar

2 teaspoons prepared mustard

2 teaspoons Worcestershire sauce

2 drops Tabasco

1 teaspoon salt

1/4 teaspoon ground pepper

3/4 cup mayonnaise or salad dressing

If desired, add more seasoning. Have consistency soft enough to permit potato chips to be dipped in easily. Refrigerate until ready to serve. About 30 minutes before serving remove from refrigerator, whip to fluff and soften. Pile in chilled bowl. Garnish with radish slices, serve with crackers, potato chips or melba toast. Yield: one quart.
