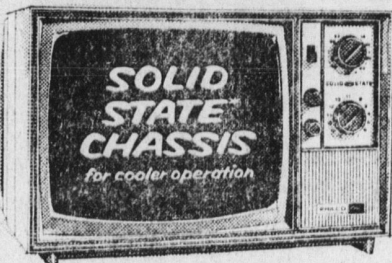

**IRS Jobs
Now Available**

Greensboro, N. C. — An unusually large number of recent retirements has created many job openings in the Internal Revenue Service, especially among accountants and tax collection officers, according to J. E. Wall, District Director for IRS.

Wall said that starting salaries for revenue agents (accountants) range from \$7410 to \$8650 per year.

Wall added that young men eligible for military draft are welcome to apply for those positions if they qualify.

Director Wall issued a call today for anyone with a college degree in accounting or with qualifying experience in accounting or collection functions to contact the Personnel Officer at the IRS office in Greensboro so that details of qualifications and availability for these positions can be furnished to them.

To Be Held
In Raleigh**

RALEIGH — The 1969 "Make It Yourself With Wool" contest will be held in the auditorium of Hudson-Bell Department Store, Fayetteville St., Raleigh, on Saturday, December 6. Judging is private for the girls and judges only, but the public is invited to the style show that begins at 1:30 p.m.

According to Harriett Tutterow, extension clothing specialist, North Carolina State University, and director of the event, judging will be in three categories. There will be a sub-deb contest for girls 10-13; a junior competition for girls 14-16, and a senior contest, open to girls 17-21.

Winning fashion ensembles are selected on the basis of workmanship, beauty of design, suitability to the individual and general fashion values, Miss Tutterow explains.

The state first place junior and senior winners will represent North Carolina at the Southern Council Contest in Atlanta. Junior and senior winners of the Council will compete in the national finals in Denver, Colo.

"North Carolina winners have done well in past regional and national events," Miss Tutterow indicates.

In North Carolina the "Make It Yourself With Wool" contest is sponsored by the Women's Auxiliary to the National Wool Growers Association.

**Social Security
News**

Apparently some work done by a domestic worker in a private home is covered by social security and some is not covered. How do you determine whether the social security tax should be reported and paid on such workers?

There is really a simple rule to be followed. If an employee works in or around a private home and is paid \$50, or more, in cash wages during a calendar quarter the law requires the employer to report and pay the tax on such wages. The nearest social security office or Internal Revenue office can furnish information about reporting such wages.
