Food Prices Are Upward

RALEIGH — Rapidly rising food prices have been sending homemakers home from their marketing sightseeing more often than not. But there is some hope for relief seen in the production and consumption forecast through mid-1970's, says Mrs. Ruby Uzzle, extension consumer marketing economist, North Carolina State University.

Food prices were up about 5 levels, but for 1970, the price increase is expected to be only about 3 percent over the entire year.

What's the reason for the slow down? Mostly it's the slackening in demand for food as well as larger supplies. Consumers spent a smaller than normal percentage of their income on gains for food during 1969. Retail food sales during the year were up 4 to 4 1/2 percent with most of the sale gains due to higher prices rather than increased sales.

On a commodity basis, there will be little change in the price of beef and pork from now until spring. Coffee prices have been going up at the wholesale level and there will be retail boosts soon.

Prices of dairy products, cereal, bakery products, sugars and sweets will continue their slow, upward trend.

It's only in the larger supplies of fresh fruits, potatoes, chicken and processed fruits and vegetables that steady or lower prices are forecast, Mrs. Uzzle says.

NCSU Crop Guide Available

Detailed information on varieties of fall harvested crops for 1969 is now available to Tar Heel farmers.

The information is contained in the Research Report No. 33, a summary of the university's Official Variety Testing Program.

Dr. John C. Rice, head of the Variety Testing Program, said the report contains information on all fall harvested crops. Included are corn hybrids, grain sorghum, corn and sorghum silage, and soybeans and cotton.

The information on tobacco varieties for 1969 was released earlier in Research Report No. 32.

"Selecting the proper variety of seed is becoming more important each year," Dr. Rice remarked. "Information available in these publications should be extremely valuable in making decisions on what variety may be best in a particular area."

All varieties of seed sold for fall harvested crops in North Carolina were compared on the basis of yield, agronomic characteristics, and quality at over 60 locations. These locations include both private farms and research stations.

Copies of both Research Report No. 32 (tobacco) and No. 33 (fall harvested crops) have been sent to extension agents, agricultural teachers, and other agricultural workers in North Carolina. A few copies are still available

from N. C. State. Write to Official Variety Testing Program, Williams Hall, N. C. State University, Raleigh, N. C. 27607.

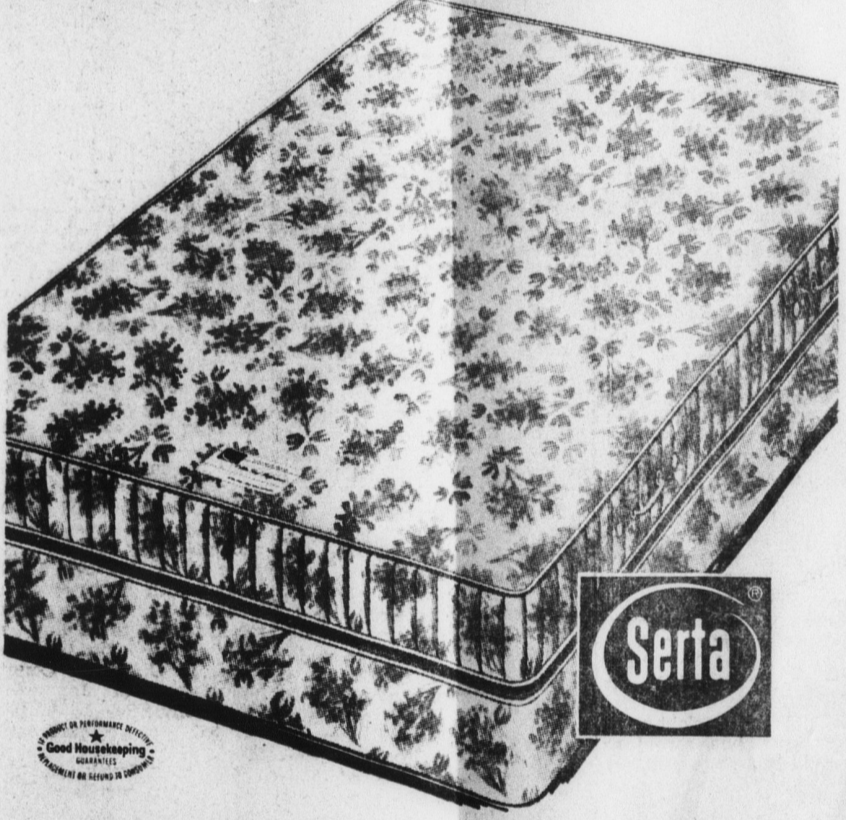

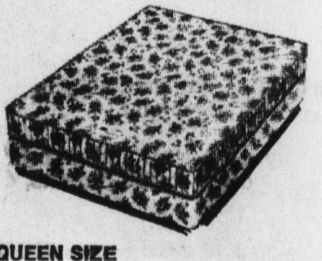
