## Reeves Brothers Rutherford Plant Makes First Resevoir Roof in East

Covered reservoirs, particular ly in the dry lands of the mid-West, have become fairly familiar sights within the last few years. But, in the East this highly expedient method of pot-able water protection had not been considered necessary until now. Today, with the increased emphasis on eliminating pollut. ants from the air, land and water, and the newly stringent health department requirements for covering potable water there is little doubt what all reservoirs will, in the near future, have roofs.

In the Fall of '69, the Moun Joy Borough Authority decided that the quality of the water for the communities of Mount Joy and Florin, Pennsylvania, would be improved if algae were pre-vented from forming, and if migratory ducks were deprived of their habitual stopover play area. Baxter Wells, superintend ent of the Authority, was familiar with the floating type of roof which requires an air filter system to allow circulation of resh air, and to prevent dust from entering.

# The Veterans Corner

EDITOR'S NOTE: Below authoritative answers by the Veterans Administration to some of the many current questions from former servicemen and their families. Further information on veterans benefits may be obtained at any VA office.

Q-I am single and receive Social Security benefits of \$150 per month, and military retirement benefits of \$90 per month. I am a patient in a nursing home due to severe disabilities. Can I qualify for a VA pension?

A Yes. You may qualify for a VA pension at a rate exceeding your military retirement benefit, which must be waived in order to receive VA payments. The VA pension rate would be \$51 a month, plus the aid and at tendance benefit of \$190. for a tal pension benefit of \$151. Q I was ordered recently to report for an examination of my

disabilities for which I am re-ceiving compensation. I did not report, and have received a let-ter discontinuing my compensa-tion. What can I do?

A-You can notify the VA by letter that you are willing to re-port for an examination, and another examination will be scheduled. The VA relaizes that there are problems in reporting for examinations, and tries to schedule them at the veteran's convenience, if possible.

Q-I am 65 years old and re tired, and receive compensation for 20 per cent disability from the Veterans Administration, Can I elect the VA pension program if it is to my financial advan-tage to do so?

A Yes. You should apply for pension. When a veteran is qualified for both compensation and pension, the VA pays the higher
