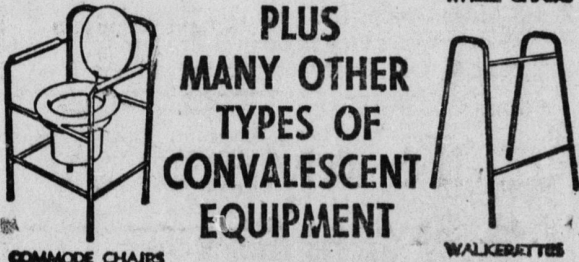

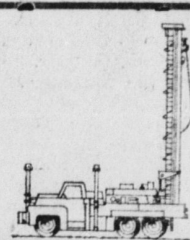

## Whitener Charges Lack of Concern

**HILDEBRAN** — Former Congressman Basil L. Whitener, one of a large group of Democratic candidates speaking at the Burke County Democratic Labor Day Rally, said that the Republican leadership was failing to show concern for average Americans. The rally and watermelon slicing was sponsored by the Icard Township Democratic Club and held at the Hildebran high school.

"The United States Labor Department reported in August that real wages of textile and furniture workers in America have been reduced in the past year, after adjustment for higher living costs and changes in Federal taxes," the popular former Congressman asserted.

"The weekly real earnings of the textile workers are down \$3.67 per week, while those of the furniture worker are down \$4.79

per week," the veteran legislator continued. "And, these figures are based upon the worker getting a full week at current wage rates."

"When we couple this loss in real wages with the lost time and unemployment in both textiles and furniture, we begin to understand the need for someone in government to be concerned for our future. The handmaiden of Republican leadership failures is lack of concern for the average American. It is now time to move America forward again," continued the astute attorney and candidate for Congress.

Bill Taylor's Famous Girl Cloggers, a popular Gastonia mountain dance group, provided entertainment. Ronald Childers, president of the Icard Democratic Club, presided at the meeting. The 200 watermelons consumed at the rally were furnished by Homer Biggers, candidate for Sheriff.

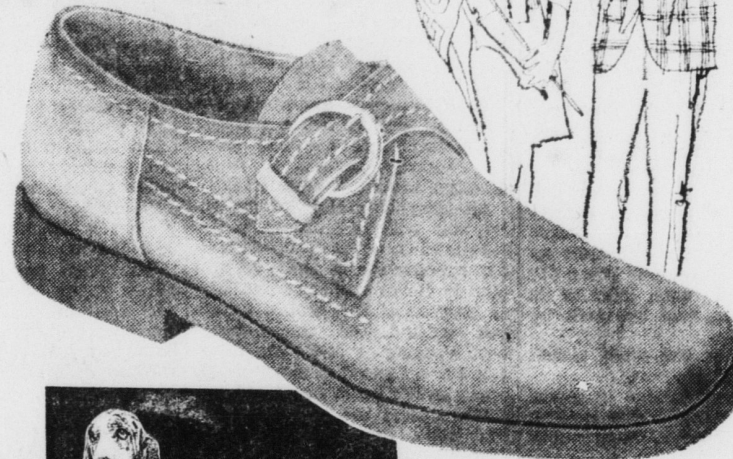

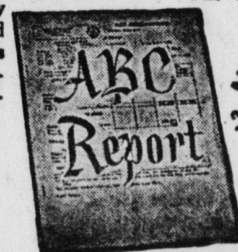
