Teszler Library Dedication Held

Sandor Teszler of Spartanburg founder of Duplex Shannon of Kings Mountain and a former Kings Mountain citizen, was honored in special ceremonies Saturday at Wofford college in Spartanburg, S. C.

The Sandor Teszler Library was formally dedicated in his honor at 2:30 p.m. ceremonies.

Mr. Teszler is now associated with Olymphia Mills. While in Kings Mountain he received a merit award from the City of Kings Mountain "in recognition

of outstanding contributions to the growth of the city."

In commenting on Mr. Teszler's contribution to Wofford college, President Paul Hardin, III said:

Sandor Teszler was born on June 25, 1903, in Budapest, Hungary. At an early age he exhibited an insatiable urge for learning, especially in the fields of

Mr. Teszler was graduated by the city (Budapest) school sys-tem at the age of 18, ranking a mong the first ten on the nation al I evel. His matriculation thesis in the field of literature was deemed of such excellence that it was reposited in the national archives. He then entered the University of Chemnitz (Germany) where he studied Textile Engineering. Upon completion of the prescribed curriculum, he joined the mercantile firm established by his brother in Zagreb, Yugoslav Largely because of his perceptive ness and initiative the original merchandising organization was rapidly transformed into a thrily try. Although the initial activities began under very modest circum stances, by 1928 the organization became of major industrial sig nificance, and by 1941 it expand ed into a vertical textile indus try encompassing fiber manufac-turing, spinning, dyeing, weav-ing, knitting, and hosiery plants, as well as ladies' and men's underwear and outerwear manufac

After World War II the indus trial was untly nationalized and partly and to Ru sa by the partly Russian Armed Forces.

However, Mr. Teszler was in vited to join a select group of industrialists responsible building the postwar Hungarian

All during this period, Mr. Teszler quietly labored to secure an opportunity for his children to grow up in a free society. In Febwary of 1948 he succeeded in leaving Hungary and emigrated to the United States, where he a gain resumed his business activities and became an outstanding

In all of these busy years Mr. Teszler always found time to pursue his deep love for litera-ture and music. He always looked for converts to the Muse am the younger people and unselfishly devoted his time to further their interest and guide their edu

His constant example of integ rity, industry, and deep concern for human values made him an outstanding and well loved lead er in all endeavors and spurred all those associated with him to strive for excellence in their professional and private lives.
