have most of their players back from last year's team which finished second in the Southwestern 4-A Conference.

Coach Gibson says he'll try to play all 22 of his players in the non-conference games.

"These two games are to decide on a starting lineup for our Southwestern Conference opener with Crest on March 17," says Gibson. "The boys will have to prove themselves in these two games."

Gibson, who has been working with his pitchers and catchers for three weeks, met with his entire squad for the first time Monday. The entire team was supposed to begin practice last week but the bad weather and the racial situations at KMHS postponed the opening of pre-season drills.

"We've been outside all this week," says Gibson. "We've been working mostly on battling practice and infield but we expect to start taking less batting practice and begin work on game situations."

Gibson has several starters returning off last year's team, which finished 12-7-1 overall and second in the SWC. The former Lenoir Rhyne hurler figures as his pitching staff comes through for the conference title.

Coach David Bolin, a 300-plus hitter for the past two years, heads the list of Mountaineer prospects. Other returning starters include first baseman Grafton Withers, second baseman Robbie Moore, shortstop Keith Parker, outfielders Tim Echols and Danny Hartsoe and pitcher Rick Hord.

Hord and Kenny Farias are the only boys listed on the pitching roster but Gibson says Parker and Hartsoe will also see mound action. Both saw relief action last spring.
