Separate bids will be received as follows:

(1) Furnishing, fabricating and delivering to the job site the Structural Metals and Joists.

The work consists of furnishing, fabricating and delivering to the job site all of the structural framing and steel joists along with all plates, anchor bolts and connectors complete and ready for erection by others.

## The Veterans Corner

Editor's Note: Veterans and their families are asking thousands of questions concerning the benefits of their government provides for them through the Veterans Administration. Below are some representative queries. Additional information may be obtained at any VA office.

Q.—My local VA office has denied me a home loan guarantee on a duplex house I wish to buy. However, I believe I have a good deal. What can I do?

A.—You may write the VA regional director requesting a review of your case. At the same time any additional information that would help your cause should be included in this communication.

Q.—I read that a new laboratory technique invented by VA is revolutionizing medicine and science. What is it, and what is it used for?

A.—Radioimmunoassay (RIA) is a medical technique that measures extremely small amounts of substance from the body. It is being used in some hospitals in connection with treatment; for testing blood for hepatitis, and for cancer and other research.

Q.—I will be discharged in September, but would like to file an application for schooling now. How do I do this?

A.—There is nothing to prevent you from applying to a school now. After acceptance by the school, contact VA. Make sure you have a copy of discharge paper (DD-214) so VA can authorize educational benefits under the G. I. bill.
