During the past six months, a total of \$562,416 in food stamps was issued to residents of Cleveland county, according to United State Department of Agri-culture's Food and Nutrition Service, Chalotte, N. C. Of this amount, \$322,497.75 was the "free" or bonus portion. An average of 4,045 persons partici-pated each month. The cash outlay or purchase requirement totaled \$239,£18.25.
