



KM Midgets Defeat Dallas Tuesday, 7-6

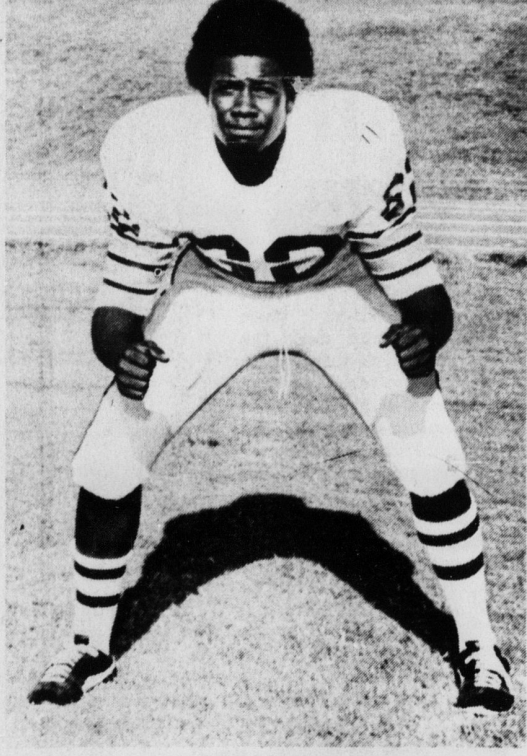

The KM-Shelby jayvee game, originally scheduled for last Thursday night at John Gamble Stadium, was washed out and rescheduled for Thurs., Oct. 14 at 7:30 p. m.

The jayvees, who dropped a heartbreaking 6-0 decision to a strong Crest team in their season's opener two weeks ago, travel to Clover tonight for a 7:30 game.

The Kings Mountain Junior High game at Burns, which was scheduled for last Thursday afternoon at Burns, was called until Thurs., Nov. 4 and will be the Patriots' last game of the season.

Also, tonight's regularly scheduled game between the Patriots and Lincolnton has been postponed until Saturday night at 7:30 p. m. because of the city's

bicentennial celebration. Saturday's game will be at John Gamble Stadium. The Patriots, who tied Shelby and Crest for the Foothills Conference crown a year ago, are off to another good start, having beaten East Rutherford and Rutherfordton in their first two outings. Lincolnton, also, is off to
