The curtain will go up at 7:30 p. m. Saturday and

Lindsay Holmes has the title role of "Peter Pan" and her brother, Chris, the lead male role of Captain Hook. Supporting roles will be played by Brenda Lepley as Windy, David Jones as John and Lee Neisler as Michael, who portray the "Darling" children.

Jim Champion has been hard at work creating the settings for the play which include a nursery, "Never Land," Mermaid Lagoon, Home Under The Ground and Pirate's Ship.

In addition to busy rehearsals for the upcoming production, under able direction of Sylvia (Mrs. Ray) Holmes, LT members have been installing a new lighting system and putting the finishing touches on two spacious new dressing rooms and extending the stage to 18 feet.

Boots McDaniel, veteran LT member, has been busy with needle and thread, sewing and hanging long, elegant gold crushed velvet draperies which now enhance the stage and auditorium. The materials were donated by Henry Neisler of Dicey Fabrics and give a beautiful "new look" to the home of the Little Theatre.

L-T officers estimate that over \$1,000 has been spent in refurbishing and that more funds are needed to complete the decor and make other improvements.

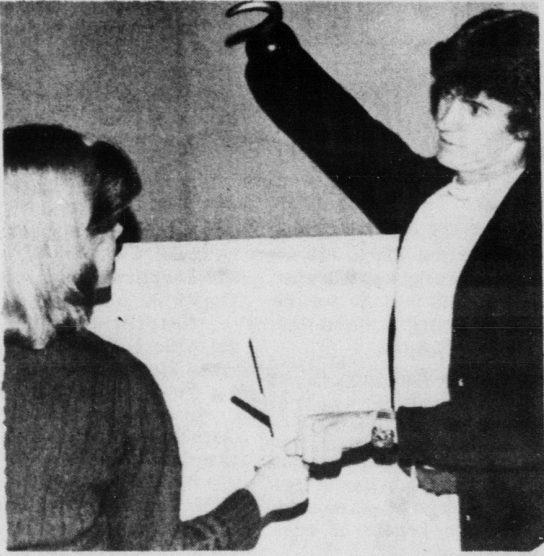
