

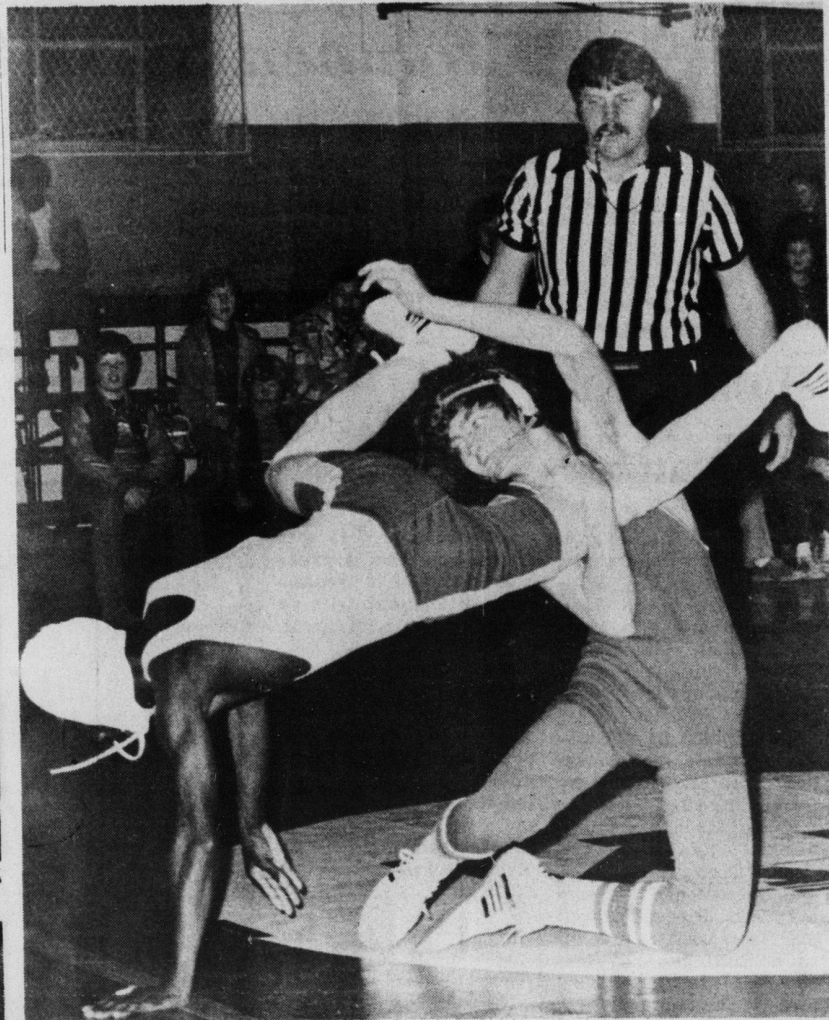

## KM Junior High Matters Cop Win Number Three

Kings Mountain Junior High's wrestlers struggled to a 38-29 victory over Robinson Road last Wednesday at Central School to run their early-season record to 3-0.

Wednesday afternoon, Coach Steve Moffitt takes his grappler to Hudson, where they'll probably

face their toughest test yet. "We didn't practice any over the holidays," noted Moffitt, "and I think it showed against Robinson Road. Hudson will be plenty tough for us this Wednesday, so we'd better be ready."

### Junior High

#### Plays Here

Kings Mountain Junior High's basketballers open the home portion of their 1977 season Thursday afternoon against R-S Central.

Coach Ken Napier's charges, who are the defending Foothills Conference champions, were scheduled to open yesterday at East Rutherford but the results were not available at the Mirror-Herald's press deadline.

The Patriots are coming off a 18-0 season but Napier is working with an entirely new team. He feels his club can be a contender if it matures quickly but the veteran mentor points to Shelby, Crest and Burns as the teams to beat.

Today's game at the KMJH gym gets underway at 4 p. m.

Meanwhile, Coach Danny McDowell's jayvees are preparing for their opener next Monday against Burns.

Only one of McDowell's players, Mark Scruggs, played on last year's jayvee team, which finished 4-9. But McDowell feels his players have the potential.

Some of the players he'll be counting on include Carl Smith, Chris Wright, Craig Roberts, Craig Champion, Terrence Bialock, Sylvester Hamrick, Vince Roseboro, Ricky Proctor and Scruggs.

The Patriots won their first four matches last week for a 22-0 lead but the visitors from Rock Hill recovered and almost pulled the match out.

Maurice Jamerson, a 147-pounder, clinched the decision for KMJH when he won his match on a pin. His victory made the score 38-18 but Robinson Road won the next two matches and tied the last one to cut the final score to a seven-point margin.

Wednesday's foe, Hudson, is one of the top clubs in the Northwestern Conference and last season was unbeaten going into its match with the Patriots. KM won that one by only three points.
