

## Broyhill Elected Rural Caucus Vice Chairman

Congressman James T. Broyhill has been elected vice chairman of the Congressional Rural Caucus. Earlier in the week Broyhill had been elected

to the Executive Committee of the Caucus.

Responding to inquiries about his election and the work of the Rural Caucus Broyhill said, "The Congressional Rural Caucus, since its organization has been an increasing effective voice in the House of Representatives in behalf of the needs of the people of our nation's rural and small town areas. Too often in the past, Congress had adopted legislation which provided benefits for our nation's large metropolitan areas while too often leaving our small town and rural areas to fend for themselves."

"This neglect of rural America's need has resulted in millions of Americans, over the past decades leaving rural areas and migrating to

urban and suburban environments in search of employment and better living conditions. The consequences of this historic migration have been over crowded urban and suburban schools, massive urban unemployment and rapidly increasing urban and suburban crime rates," Broyhill said.

"Congress' response has historically been to fund programs to alleviate these problems facing urban and suburban America rather than getting to the root of the problem and improving housing, health care, job opportunities and other problems, facing rural America," Broyhill went on to state.

Broyhill said he believes it is essential for the Congress to fully realize that all Americans benefit when the needs of rural America are dealt with effectively.

"I welcome the challenge of this new leadership role within the Congressional Rural Caucus and look forward to playing an important part in focusing the attention of the 96th Congress on the needs of our nation's people living in small town and rural areas," the veteran lawmaker said.
