The city of Kings Mountain is still operating smoothly its natural gas system despite the fact the Federal Power Commission cut the 1976-77 allocations by 20 percent. Local industry was given another

shock last week when the FPC announced possible further curtailment in gas allocations. However, that order was held in check for the time being. Mayor John H. Moss said today

"We will utilize the peak shaving plant at maximum capacity when economically feasible to augment our natural gas supply. This should help the situation with our local industry and business."

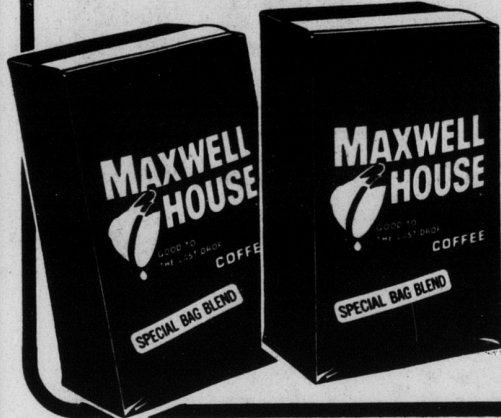
