handling city recreation is doing a successful job, but that with the improvements the community will see even more beneficial recreational programs underway. In his motion for recreational activities, Commissioner Grissom told the board such things as a tennis tournament, softball tournament, swimming events, and other competitive tournaments are highly recommended by the committee under sponsorship by the city recreation department.

In other action Monday night, commissioners accepted the recommendation from Southeastern Consulting Engineers, Inc. to hire low bidders for electrical materials to be used to provide service to York Road Shopping Center, Riddle Manufacturing to Linwood Rd. and to Northwoods Subdivision.

The low bidders were:
Scamble on poles — \$7,820.00; Mill Power Supply on crossarms — \$3,293.20; Rigby Electric on in-

ulators — \$1,984.80; Bryant Electric on conductors — \$10,627; Rigby on conductor accessories — \$843.60; Bryant on pole line hardware — \$6,727; Mill Power on transformers — \$27,290.10; and Mill Power on underground materials — \$1,792.79.

The total price is \$60,378.99. Bill Little Jr., professional engineer with Southeastern, told the board there were 10 bidders, but not all companies bid on all groups of materials.

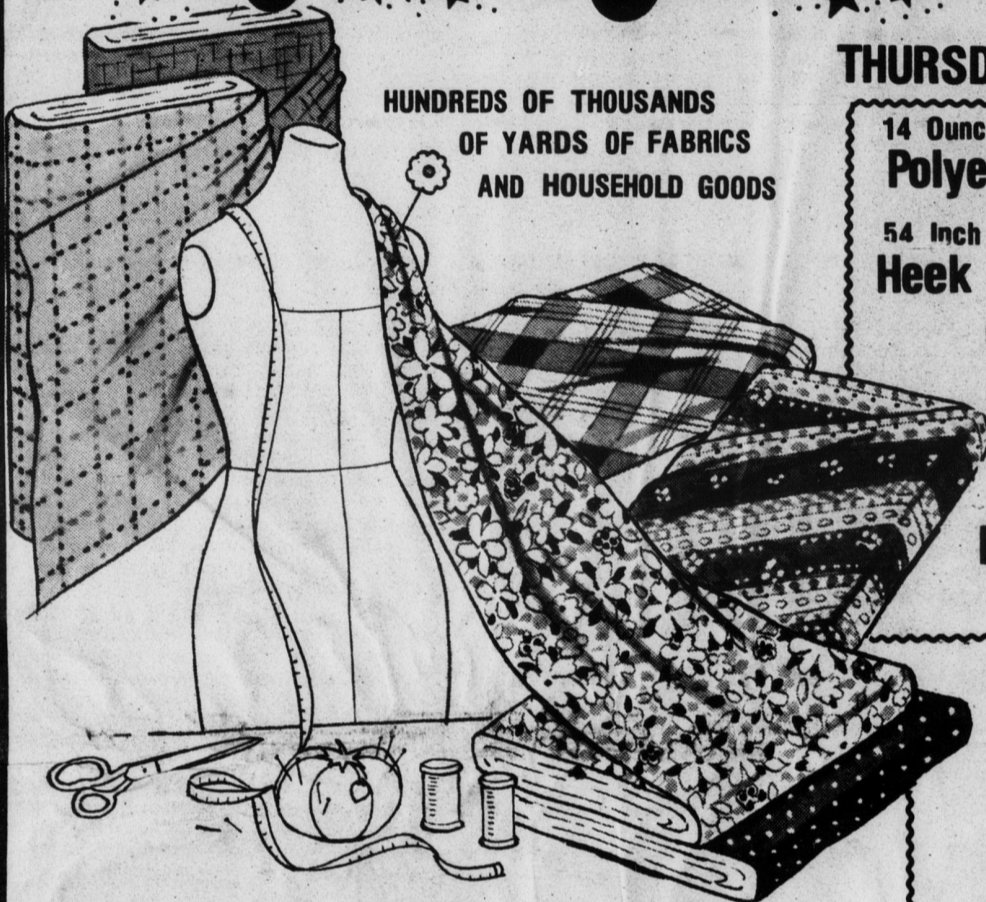

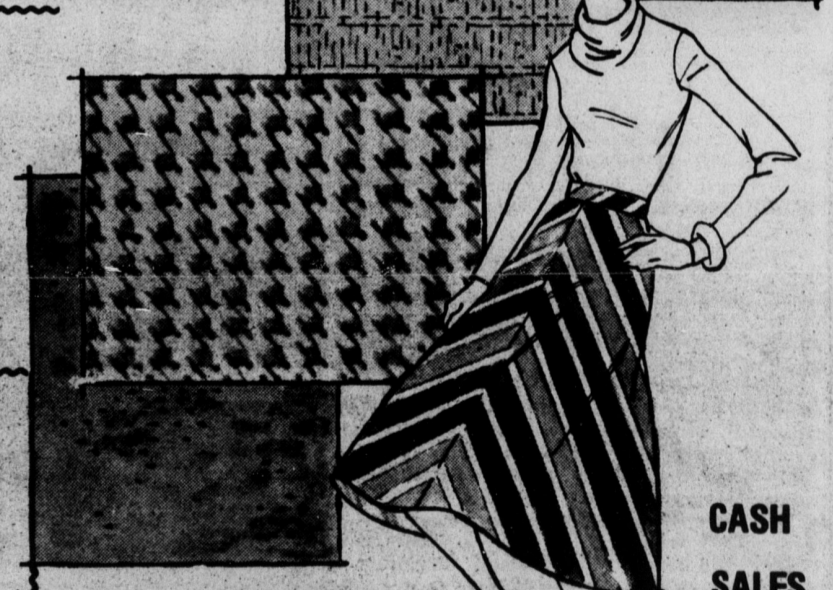
