- Q. Why isn't Food Town open on Sundays like so many other grocery stores? E.M.
- A. The management of Food Town feels that the Sabbath should be observed, thereby giving their employees a day of worship, rest, and relaxation.
- O. Why do some supermarkets raise prices of merchandise even though the merchandise is already on the shelf and

- A. Our understanding is that all other supermarkets do raise prices and do so because of the extra profits they generate by raising prices.
- Q. Does Food Town do this also? B.H.
- A. Food Town does not raise prices of merchandise already marked. However, if a price declines Food Town immediately passes this on to their customers by reducing the selling price.

Simply stated, Food Town does not change the price of a 27-cent item that is already marked and on the shelf to 29 cents. It will, however, change that 27-cent item to 25 cents if and when the price is reduced.

- Q. A lot of supermarkets are staying open for 24 hours. Why hasn't Food Town followed this trend? A.F.
- A. Normally a store stays open for just one reason to increase sales. Food Town's management feels that customers are more interested in lower prices than longer hours and that
