 The Cleveland County Board of Health will meet at Hager's Restaurant on Thursday morning at 7:30 a. m. for a budget-planning meeting.

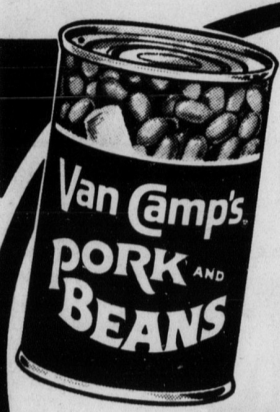
Ceramic Course Planned
