

Nip EL In Eight Innings

Patriots Cop 21st Straight 5-4

baseball game. The Patriots won, 5-4, giving them four straight wins this spring and 21 straight over the past three years.

Ricky Chapman squeezed Ricky Proctor home with the winning run in the bottom of the eighth inning Tuesday afternoon at Lancaster Field Number Two to give Kings Mountain Junior High a hard-earned 5-4 victory over East Lincoln.

It was the 21st straight Foothills Conference victory for the Patriots. Coach Porter Griggs takes his charges to Shelby this afternoon to face the pre-season Foothills favorites, and they remain on the road Friday, playing R-S Central in a makeup game.

Tuesday's victory was KM's fourth straight this year, but the Patriots had to come from three runs down to tie the game and send it into an extra inning.

Proctor walked, stole second and went to third on a wild pitch to set up Chapman's game-winning bunt.

Tim Leach, who relieved Jeff Cloninger in the sixth, picked up the victory. He's been the winning pitcher in all four Patriot victories.

Cloninger and Leach combined for 12 strikeouts, Cloninger fanning seven and Leach five.

Chapman, Cloninger and Eric Dixon had two hits apiece to lead KM's 10-hit plate attack.

The Patriots opened the scoring in the first on singles by Cloninger, Lyn Hayes and Leach, but East Lincoln came back with a single run in the third and three in the fifth to take a 4-1 lead.

KM cut it to 4-3 with two

runs in the fifth, with Dixon's double plating both. Walks to Mike Spears and Chapman and Mark Schuman's single set up the play.

The Patriots tied it in the seventh on a walk to Spears and singles by Chapman and Cloninger.
