The wedding will take place Sunday, May 1, at 3 p. m. in Kings Mountain Church of God.

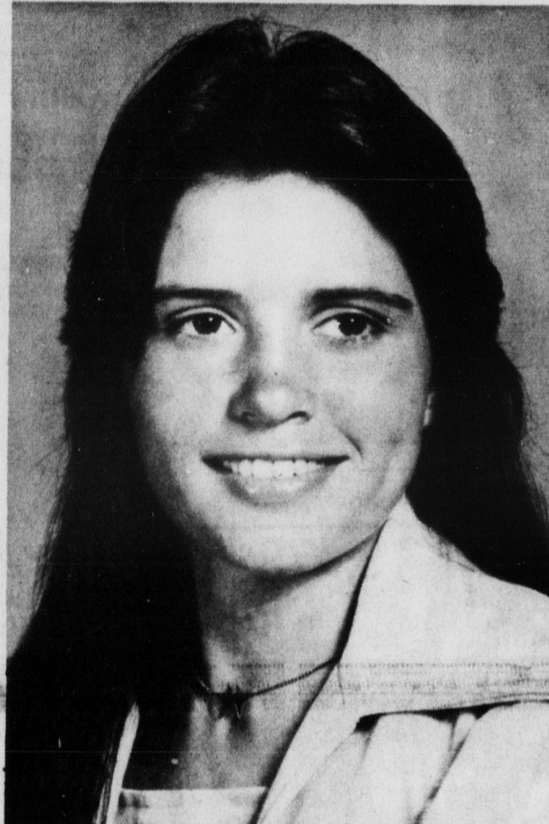
A reception will be held after the ceremony in the church fellowship hall.

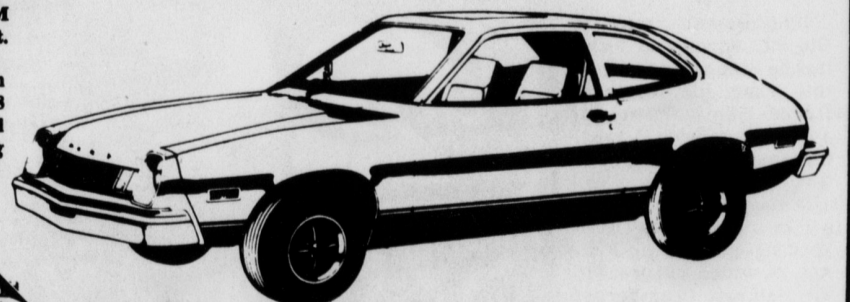
