

# 18 KMHS Students Are Selected

Eighteen students at Kings Mountain Senior High School have been honored this week by election to Mu Alpha Theta, International high school and junior college mathematics club.

The announcement was made by Dr. Harold V. Huneke, national secretary-treasurer, who is a professor of mathematics at the University of Oklahoma where the national office is located. Only those schools with excellent mathematics programs can earn membership in the club

since all courses in mathematics and the qualifications of the mathematics faculty and students are examined in detail by the club's Governors and National Officers.

To be eligible for membership, minimum requirements are that a student must have completed with distinction at least four semesters of college preparatory mathematics and be enrolled in the fifth semester. He also must have an overall grade average of at least a "B"
