A. M. Pullen
 Is Retained
 As Auditor

The city has contracted for the sixth consecutive year with A. M. Pullen Co. to handle the annual audit.

Joe Augburn, Pullen representative, was on hand Monday night to solicit the audit account. Augburn has personally worked the Kings Mountain audit since 1964.

Barry Jenkins, CPA of Kings Mountain, was the only other bidder for the audit business. Jenkins quoted the city a price of \$15 per hour and expenses. The Pullen fee was \$16 per hour and expenses.

Commissioner Jim Childers moved to hire Pullen "based on their past experience as the city auditors."
