Community Market Policy Is Set

At Monday's commissioners meeting Mayor John H. Moss announced the policy for operation of the community Market located at the KM Depot Center.

Mayor Moss said the two structures should be ready for use by this weekend during the Ole' Timey Town Meeting and depot center dedication ceremony.

The policy consists of 28 items governing the permitted use of the market.

The selling space, for instance, will be limited to

residents or Kings Mountain and immediate vicinity, probably the onemile perimeter. The space can be used for selling of farm produce by those who raise the produce and for handcrafts made by the

The policy also limits the employes of one producer of handcraft maker to work only for that employer. An employe cannot sell for more than one person in the market.

The mayor said the market will be open daily, except Sunday, from 6 a. m. - 8 p. m. each week during the year, holidays excluded. However, the ssee of any stall may close his or her operation at any hour during the day

as conditions warrant. Tables will be leased for \$2 per day, \$6 per week, \$20 per month and rent is payable in advance. The mayor said that any tenant who does not occupy the space assigned for the days set or fails to open for business no later than 8:80 a. m. will lose the assigned

space for that day. The policy also covers the size of display signs and the type of wrapping

for edible products.

And, according to the mayor, prombits selling such items as ham biscuits, etc. The market will also be governed by the State Compulsory Meat Inspective Law and the Federal Meat Inspection Act, which means that no uninspected meat products can be sold at the market.

The policy covers in detail the items that be sold to the public, either at the market or anywhere in the state.

Also no livestock, such as cattle, hogs, pigs, sheep

and such will be permitted inside the market for sale. No dogs are allowed inside the market. No poultry, hens and fryers will be sold in the market building.

Price fixing is also prohibited by lessees of market space.

To protect the tenants the city will not allow selling of similar items within 600 feet of the community market.

Complete details of policy are available upon request from the city, along with the lease agreement that must be signed before operation

The community market structures are made of concrete floors, brick structures and wooden pens and the brick and olor scheme is compatible with the depot center.




