

Earns Spot In State Tourney Darrell Austin Wins Shelby Jaycee Tourney

Kings Mountain's Darrell Austin Jr. copped the annual Shelby Jaycees Junior Golf Tournament Wednesday and Thursday at Woodbridge Country Club and will represent the area in the state tournament in Wilmington next month.

Austin fired a 75-75-150 to win the event by one

stroke over Claude Reid of Gastonia. Reid scored a 76-76-151.

Austin, Reid, David Cash of Shelby and Dan Taylor of Gastonia all qualified for the state event. Cash shot 156 and Taylor 157. Chet Chestnut of Gastonia won the 12-14 year old division with a 36-hole score of 162. Blair Butler of

Shelby was second with 168.

Gaston Bates of McAdenville won the 9-11 year old title with a 193 and Brandon Jaynes of Shelby was second at 197.

Jimmy England of Gastonia, the defending champion, earned one of

the three alternate spots by shooting a 160. Rick Henson of Rutherfordton and Glen Deck of Spindale grabbed the other two alternate spots with scores of 188 and 180, respectively.

Thirty-four area golfers competed in the tournament.

Tim Riddle Is Second In Tourney

Tim Riddle of Kings Mountain finished second last week in the annual Greensboro Invitational Tennis Tournament.

Riddle, who recently led Kings Mountain High to the Western N. C. High Schools Activities Association title, lost out in the championship match to second-seeded Barry Cox of Greenville, S. C., 6-2, and 6-3.

Riddle, who was seeded third, knocked off top-seeded Greg Cooper of Birmingham, Ala., 6-7, 6-3 and 6-3 in the semi-finals to earn the championship spot against Cox. Cooper was ranked fourth in the state of Alabama and 19th in the south.

Riddle won three earlier matches in straight sets, defeating Paul Kroeger of Winston-Salem 6-2, 6-0; David Allen of Raleigh 6-3, 6-1; and Billy Pritchard of Charlotte 6-1, 6-0.

This week, Riddle will be competing in the Southern-Closed Tennis Tournament in Nashville, Tenn. He qualified for that event by placing seven in the annual qualifying round in Winston-Salem.

The locals dropped two more games last week, losing a tough 9-8 decision to Hickory on Thursday night at a 10-6 loss to

Cherryville Saturday. Post 155 travels to Shelby Thursday and Forest City Saturday.

Post 155 had Hickory on the ropes for the second time this year Thursday, coming from behind to tie it at 7-all after seven innings.

But Hickory took advantage of three bases on balls and a couple of KM errors to score two in the bottom of the eighth for a 9-7 advantage.

Post 155 came back to score one in the ninth on Mike Jackson's single and a double by Rusty Bell, but Buster Dobbins fled deep to left to end the game.

Jackson's fourth home run of the year in the top of the second gave Post 155 a brief 1-0 lead over Cherryville Saturday but the hot Cherryville club came back to take a 7-1 lead after four.

Post 155 battled back with four in the top of the eighth to cut it to 9-5 and Cherryville had to call on ace righthander Joel Burgess to put out the fire. The victory was Cherryville's fourth straight.

Heading into tonight's game, Post 155 has the hottest hitter in Area Four in Jackson, the Clover High standout who is headed to Livingstone College in Alabama on a football-baseball grant-in-aid. Jackson is hitting .576 with 19 hits, four homers and 14 runs batted in.
