KM dropped its first game Saturday night in the quarter-finals, losing a tough 6-5 decision to Macon County. KM outhit Macon 12-5 but left 15 runners on base. Glass and Whisnant led the KM attack with three hits each.

Graham ousted the local team Saturday night, 17-8. Hampton led KM with three hits and 487, Hampton 438, Donna Myers, Judy Whisnant and Susan Howze added two each.

For the tourney, Ginger Martin hit .714,

Glass .526, Judy Whisnant .500, Ross .500, Myers .487, Howze .487, Hampton .438, Blanton .421, Mary Ann White .294, Leslie Hamrick .286, Williams .283, Trudy Whisnant .182 and Kim Gladden .100.

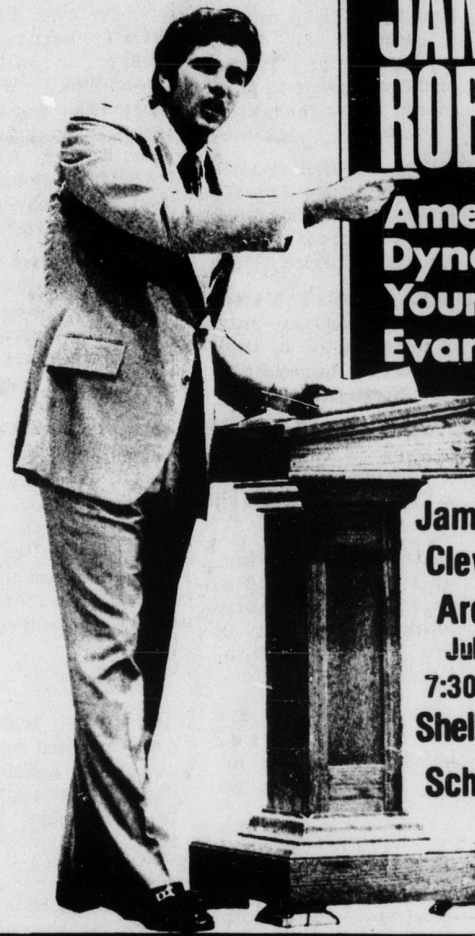
