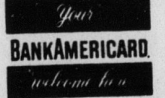

PETITION

We, the undersigned Paul Mauney and wife, Lillian R. Mauney, of 3600 Margrace Road, Kings Mountain, North Carolina, do hereby petition the Board of Commissioners of the City of Kings Mountain to rezone 26.77 acres, more or less, located on the North side of U. S. Highway 74 near the proposed intersection with U. S. Highway 74-By Pass of which we are owners in fee simple, from R-8 (two family residential district) to L-1 (light industry). Said property being more particularly described as follows:

First Tract: Beginning at a small black oak and runs N. 44 E. 53 poles to a post oak, Dickey's corner; thence N. 46 W 100 poles with Dickey's line to a stump on North bank of the branch; thence N. 22 poles to stake on Dickey's line; thence N 71 W. 46 poles to a pine, corner of Lot No. 2; thence S 76 poles to a stake; thence S. 46 E. 108 poles to the Beginning, containing 49 acres, more or less.
