Few infants at birth have hereditary or congenital defects of the feet. Yet by age 10, 50 percent of youngsters have developed some kind of foot defect, and at age 20, we find a shocking 80 percent with foot disorders or defects. This includes corns, callouses, bunions, hammer toes and fallen arches. A major cause of these foot abnormalities is misfitted shoes. It is surprising how much foot damage can result from only one pair of misfit shoes. Naturally, out grown shoes, or shoes that are fitted too small are the worst offenders. Parents should use great care to see that children's shoes are properly fitted.
