

Registration Set At Tech

The Continuing Education Department of Cleveland Tech has announced that persons interested in enrolling in the spring quarter ceramics classes may register at the Shelby City Park arts and craft building Monday through Thurs., Feb. 6 through 16, at the following days and hours:

The registration of \$5 plus the cost for materials should be paid at the registration time. Persons are requested to register on the day and at the time the particular class is scheduled. A unique feature with this announcement is that pottery and ceramics is being offered Thursday morning, and a person can register for either class.

These classes are scheduled to meet in the arts and crafts building at Shelby City Park. Beginning students are asked to register at the beginner class times, on Wednesday and Thursday. Ms. Ada Blankenship will instruct.

All registrants in any class must be at least 18 years of age. A \$5 registration fee is required unless exempt by State law, or over 65 years of age. At least 15 students are required for the class to begin. If a class doesn't have the minimum number of students at the first planned meeting, it may try again at its second planned meeting. Persons may register for a class no later than its third session.

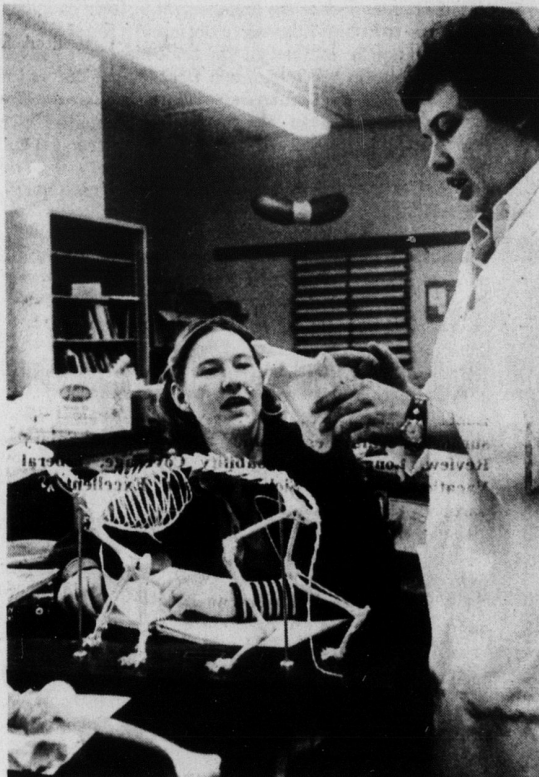
