were served to some of his kindergarten friends.

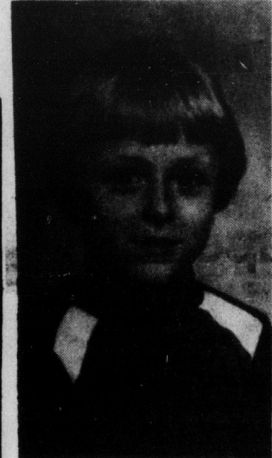
