281 Have Completed Courses

Cleveland County Red Cross Chapter has issued certificates to 281 area citizens after completion of first aid classes during the period July 1-Dec. 31.

The Chapter also presented certificates to 204 who have completed classes held in cardio pulmonary resuscitation and 54 certificates to students completing water safety classes.

A total of 2,816 pints of blood have been collected at bloodmobile visits in the county during the reporting period and service to armed forces and veterans included 18 in active service and 787 in civilian limited services, serving a total of 82 active service cases and two cases for veterans and offering financial assistance to three families.

In addition, Executive Secretary Mary Helen Timms reported that a disaster action team worked with firemen and fire victims throughout the county with teams on call to help with food, assistance for workers and disaster victims. A disaster team, said Mrs. Timms, has made radio and newspaper appeals for furniture and household goods for fire victims and transported these goods to needy families. Teams also assisted Fallston Fire Department in collection and delivery of food, clothing and household goods for the families who lost their homes and four members of the family. Seven members of the Disaster team helped with assignments during the Western Carolina floods and a disaster action team worked throughout the night during the recent ice storm by feeding workers, having available a shelter and checking on nursing homes throughout the county.

Members of the Disaster action team worked during the recent wind storm, made service available to a family forced from their home because of extensive wind damage, helped spot fallen trees and power lines and delivered cots and blankets to Kings Mountain on request of Mayor John Moss for shelter operation. They also participated in the recent disaster drill conducted by the Civil Preparedness Department at Cleveland County Law Enforcement Center and spent many hours helping to equip and learn operation of equipment in the Disaster Van.
