

Plonk Takes Course

Jodie Plonk, a Newberry College sophomore from Kings Mountain took a course designed to introduce the student to editing a literary journal.

The class was one of 43 courses that the College offered during the Interim Program which began Jan. 16 and ended Feb. 10. The Interim allowed a student to take only one subject permitting him to explore areas of interest outside his major field of study, or to engage in research of a nature that would not be possible in a regular course.

Editing a Literary Journal, under the direction of Dr. Steen Spove, Associate Professor of English, focused on the publication of one issue of "Studies in Short Fiction," a quarterly scholarly journal devoted exclusively to serious commentaries on short fiction. The journal is compiled at Newberry College with Spove serving as editor.

The students considered such problems as selecting articles and book reviews preparing manuscripts for the printer, reading galley and page proofs and selecting a cover in an endeavor to become familiar with all phases of producing a journal, according to Dr. Spove.

In addition, the class conducted visits to the R. L. Bryan Printing Company in Columbia, S. C. allowing the students to view the actual printing of the journal.

Art League Sees Slides

Ross C. Anderson, staff lecturer of the National Gallery of Art in Washington, D. C., gave a slide-illustrated short course on Impressionism to the Shelby Art League on Sunday afternoon in Brown Auditorium.

Impressionism is the school of painting of the late 1800's represented by the works of Manet, Renoir, Degas, and Monet — perhaps the most popular and familiar paintings in the United States today. This art movement marked the beginning of modern art with its emphasis on light and color and on the way an object or scene strikes the eye at a given moment — the monetary impression — rather than with a story that the painting has to tell or the careful illustration of people and events shown in earlier painting.

Mr. Anderson is the author of "Thirty Paintings in the Malden Collection." He has a B.A. from Princeton University in art and architecture and an M.A. from Harvard in nineteenth and twentieth century art and did internships in art at the Art Institute of Chicago. As a member of the staff of the National Gallery, he lectures on art and writes and edits educational materials in the arts.

The course was divided into two 45 minute sessions. Refreshments were served by members of the Shelby Art League during the intermission.
