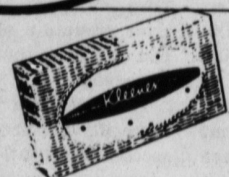

The monthly G.E.D. examination is scheduled at Cleveland Tech on Fri., Mar. 16 from 1 p. m. until 6 p. m. and will continue Sat., Mar. 17 from 9 a. m. until 2 p. m.

Both sessions are required in order to complete the test. Application may be made by any North Carolina adult 18 or older who has been out of a regular high school program for at least six months.

The examination tests knowledge and understanding of correct English, social studies, natural science, literature, and mathematics. Upon successful completion of the examination, the adult will be issued a Certificate of High School equivalency by the N. C. State Board of Education.

Applications to be tested or re-tested must be made by Fri., Mar. 10 to Mrs. Rebecca Cook or a staff member in the Learning Resources Center at Cleveland Tech, 187 S. Post Rd., Shelby.
