BLOWING ROCK - The lure of the mountains in winter is a combination of beautiful scenery adorned with ice and snow, plenty of vigorous activity — like skiing or sledding, and afterwards a cozy fire, dim lights, and food to delight the appetite.

Tony Wilson, the head chef at Hound Ears, shares recipes for three popular winter dishes which can be prepared easily and inexpensively.

And Hound Ears bartender, Jeff Hutchins, shares his recipes for hot buttered rum.

SHRIMP SALAD 1 pound green, peeled, and develned shrimp

2 boiled eggs, (chopped) 1 stalk celery (chopped) 2 tablespoons green

(chopped) 1 tablespoon cagers (optional)

relish or sweet pickles

tablespoon Worcestershire sauce 2 tablespoons lemon tuice

1 cup mayonnaise. Cook shrimp, chop and combine with ingredients. Makes four

CHICKEN TETRAZZINI

Boil one hen (two hours or until tender.) Cool. Save stock. Strip chicken from the bone and cut into strips.

Heat 21/2 cups of chicken stock. Thicken with brown sauce (melt and brown one stick of butter or margarine and add three tablespoons of flour). Add 1% cups cooked spaghetti.

Saute 1/2 cup of fresh mushrooms. Add one chopped green pepper, 2 teaspoons chopped pimientos, 2 teaspoons salt, and 1/4 teaspoon pepper.

Pour into casserole and sprinkle with grated Parmesan cheese. Bake 45 minutes at 300 degrees F., or until golden brown. Makes six servings.

> JAPANESE FRUIT PIE

1 cup sugar 2 eggs, well beaten 1 tsp. vinegar

1/2 c. broken pecans

1/2 cup coconut 1/2 cup raisins

Melt margarine in saucepan. Add sugar, mix well. Add eggs and vinegar. Stir in pecans, coconut, and raisins. Mix well. Pour into unbaked pie shell. Bake at 350 degrees F. until browned. Let set.

> HOT BUTTERED RUM

1 lb. brown sugar

16 lb. soft butter

14 to 1/4 teaspoon ground nutmeg

14 teaspoon ground cinnamon

1/2 teaspoon ground clove Pinch of salt Instructions:

1. Beat sugar and butter together until thoroughly

creamed. 2. Add nutmeg, cin-

namon, clove and salt.

3. Preheat 6-ounce mug (rinse thoroughly in hot water). Pour in one jigger of rum or use a mixture of rum and brandy or

whiskey. 4. Add 1/4 to 1 teaspoonful of batter until dissolved. Fill with hot apple cider. Float a pat of butter on top and serve with a cinnamon


