Using the self-paced individualized instruction concept in some of the

vocational courses, it is now practical and logical for students to begin at any quarter. The individual enrolling can take individual vocational courses at any time (day or night schedule).

The vocational courses auto mechanics, auto body repair, air conditioning and refrigeration, electrical installation and

maintenance, and welding are open for new students. Most of the technical courses are open and persons interested in general education are advised to begin their program at any given quarter.

A unique feature of the N. C. Community College system, "special credit," allow an adult to register

for one course from any curriculum at a time available to his/her work schedule.

## Shelby Art League Plans Series Of Talks On Antiques

The Shelby Art League will sponsor a series of talks on American Antiques in April.

Ruth Scott of Charlotte, an expert in this field, will be the speaker. The lectures will be given on April 2, 9, 16, and 23 at 2:30 p. m. in Brown Auditorium, and are open to the public at no admission charge.

Mrs. Scott has taught a class in Antiques and Antique Furnishings at the Mint Museum in Charlotte for the last five years. She

has also taught or lectured at Queens and Central Piedmont Community College. In 1974, she won the Burlington House Award for decorating with antiques and lectured on silver during the Carteret County Bicentennial Week in 1978. She is now advisor to the furnishings committee of Latta Place Restoration, a federal style house on Mountain Spring Lake in Mecklenburg County.

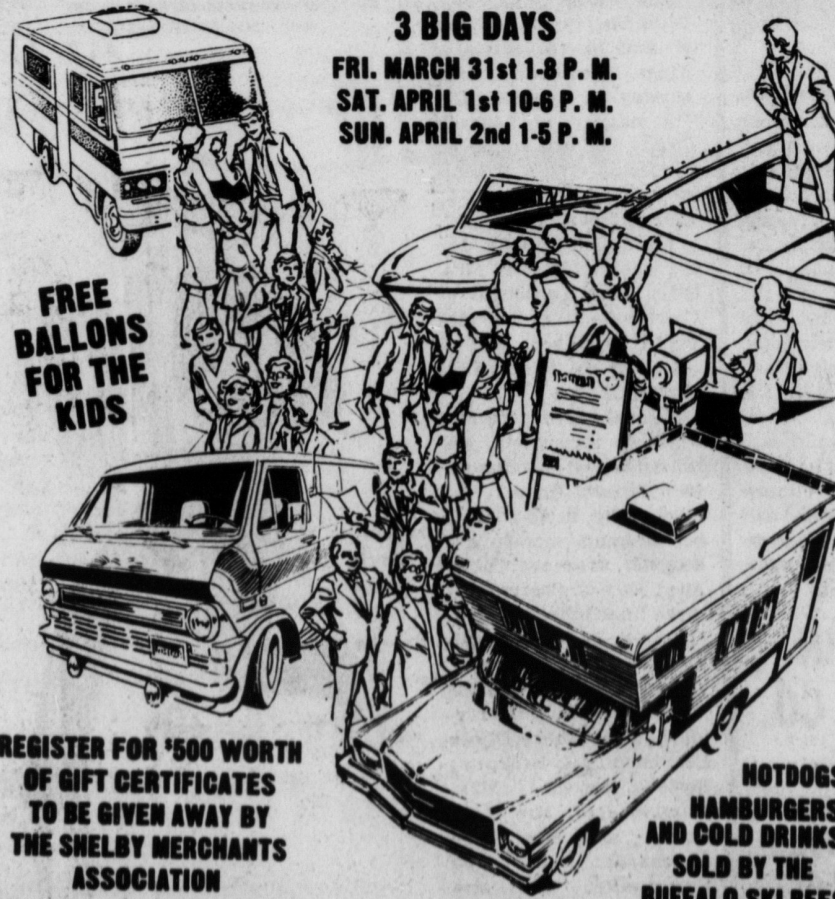
