

# Gant Has His Eyes On Rookie Of The Year

HARRISBURG, N. C. — Harry Gant, one of the most popular and talented performers in short track racing, is setting his sights on the 1979 Grand National Citicorp Rookie of the Year title and he'll launch his efforts in the upcoming May 28th World 600 at Charlotte Motor Speedway.

The Taylorsville, N. C., athlete will drive a Banjo Matthews-built Oldsmobile 442 owned by Virginia coal mining executive Kenny Childress in the rich 600-miler. It will be the first of five Winston Cup appearances in '78 for Gant who readily admits that the new team's goal is to win the 1979 rookie crown. Childress indicated that the team may compete in all 30 Grand National races during Gant's bid for the lucrative Citicorp award.

Gant, who holds the unique distinction of having been voted by the fans as the most popular driver in both the Late Model Sportsman and Modified divisions of NASCAR last year, is no stranger to superspeedway competition. He has scored long-distance Modified

wins here at Charlotte Motor Speedway and at Daytona.

Childress, who maintains a racing operation in Kingsport, Tenn., is also a proven winner. His Black Diamond Coal race cars have won the past three Late Model Sportsman national championships with L. D. Ottinger and Butch Lindley as drivers. Gant, ironically, finished second in the fight for the LMS title in both 1976 and '77.

"We're going first class," Childress said, "both with the driver and with equipment. We won't

show up for a race without having the capability of winning. When I started thinking about fielding a Grand National team Harry was the only driver I gave any serious consideration to. I've known him for five or six years and I've always had a great deal of respect for him . . . on and off the track."

Gant, all of a sudden, becomes another top-ranked three to grab Sunday's \$15,000 World 600 pole position when the qualifying scramble for \$30,000 in cash (to the top

five starters) begins Wednesday afternoon, May 24th.

World 600 Week activities roar into high gear Saturday afternoon, May 27th, with a 100-mile Late Model Sportsman event and the Canadian-American (CanAm) Challenge Series road race, a 200-kilometer battle over the 2.25-mile road-track circuit.

The 19th annual World 600 Winston Cup classic is set for a 12:30 starting time, Sunday afternoon, May 28th.

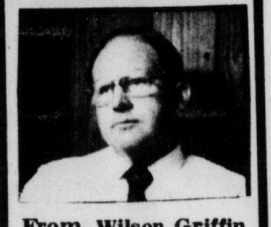
