Rev. Mr. Justice will speak on camps and opportunities they provide to young people.

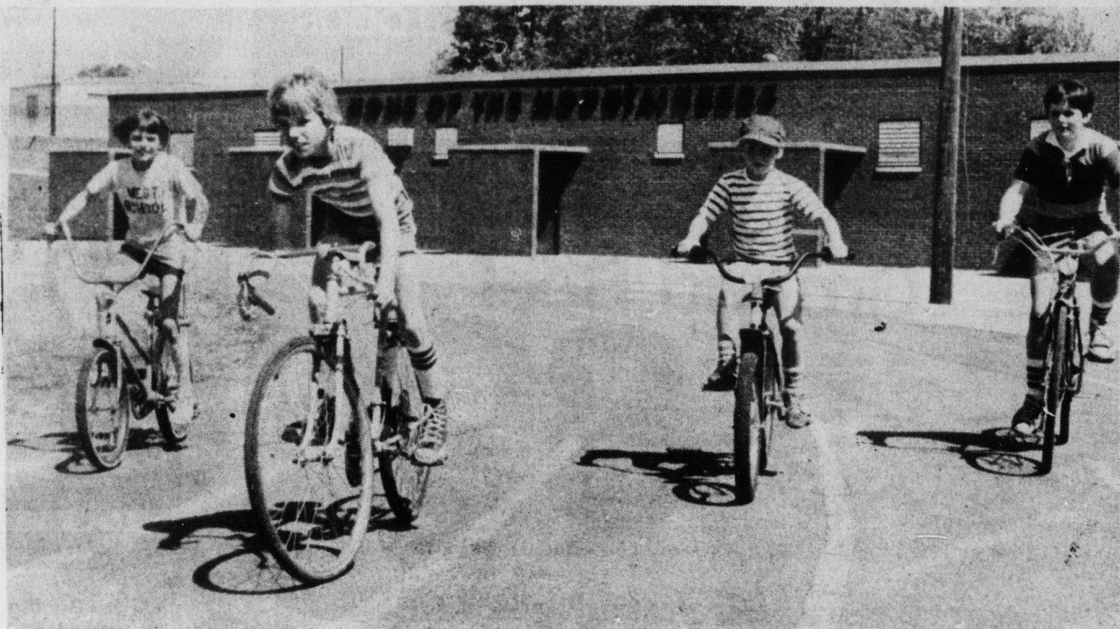
