PUBLIC HEARING

A public hearing will be held on the following rezoning petition with the Board of Commissioners on May 22, 1978 at 7:30 p. m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall:

William H. West to rezone property at 1004 Cleveland Avenue from R-10 to R-20. Property is adjacent to City Limits and is described as follows:

First Tract: Situated on the East side of the Kings Mountain and Bessemer City Road, and beginning at an iron stake placed a little under the surface of the said road and a little West from the center of said road about 8 feet S. 85 1/4 E. from a stake on the West bank of said road and runs thence with Whitesides line S. 85 1/4 E. 10.85 chains to an iron stake, near a branch; thence N. 39 E. 4.55 chains to an iron stake, Mauney's corner; thence with Mauney's line N. 85 1/4 W. 10.85 chains to an iron stake in the East edge of the Kings Mountain and Bessemer City Road, Mauney's corner; thence with said S 39 W. 4.55 chains to the beginning, containing Four and 1-10 (4.1) acres, more or less.

Second Tract: Adjoining the above tract and beginning at an iron stake, corner of the above tract and in Whitesides' line and runs with said line S. 85 1/4 E. 9.00 chains to an iron stake and pointers; thence N. 23 1/2 E. 1.09 chains to an iron stake and white oak; thence N. 63 1/2 W. 7.40 chains to an iron stake, Mauney's corner and the corner of the above tract; thence with the line of the above tract, S. 39 W. 4.55 chains to the beginning, containing Two and 1-10 (2.1) acres, more or less.

The above two tracts are the same tracts of land conveyed by deed by Boyce Payseur and wife to Will H. Jenkins dated February 4, 1920 and by a Corrective Deed on the 21st day of April, 1921.

For further title reference to the above two tracts, see deed dated the 3rd day of May, 1921 from Will H. Jenkins and wife, to Boyce R. Payseur and now on record in the Office of the Register of Deeds for Cleveland County in Book JJJ at Page 79.

Note: There is a deed from Sarah E. Payseur to J. Baxter Payseur and wife in Book 6-D at Page 606 for an acre. This .46 of an acre is included in the two tracts described above and is conveyed herewith to William Henry West and wife, Mary Wykle West.

Note: The last recorded deed on this property was in 1921 to Boyce R. Payseur in Book JJJ at Page 79. Boyce R. Payseur died intestate sometime between 1933 and 1937 leaving surviving, his widow, Sarah E. Payseur, a son, J. Baxter Payseur, a son, Boyce Glenn Payseur, and a daughter, Eva Payseur. Sarah E. Payseur, Widow, is deceased. Boyce Glenn Payseur and Eva Payseur were never married and both are deceased leaving J. Baxter Payseur as the sole surviving heir of Boyce R. Payseur and Sarah E.
