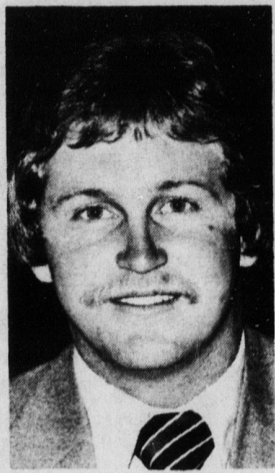


# Eaker Graduates WCU
