Meets Today

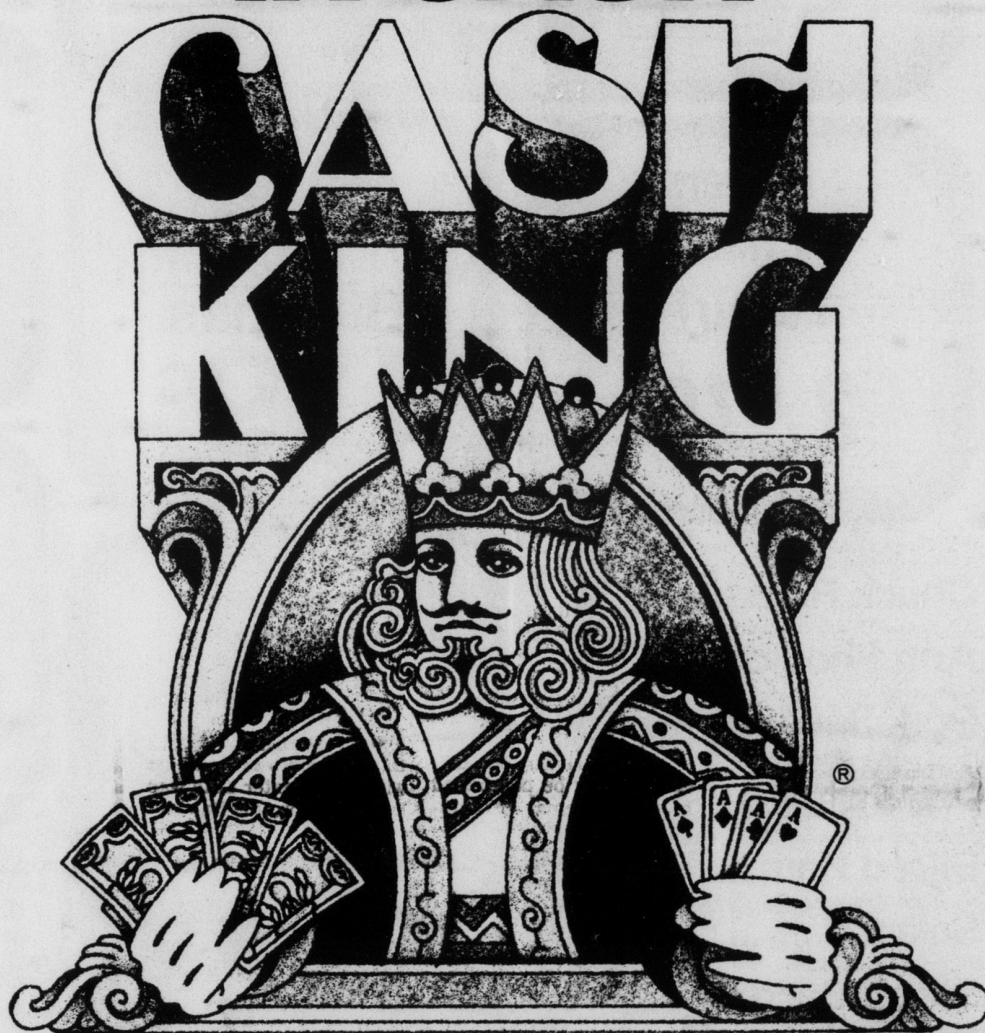
Cleveland County Technical Institute Board of Trustees will meet at 6:30 tonight in the tech conference room.
