taxes. People can't stand any more taxes."

Hinnant said recreation, as he sees it, will be a heavy topic in the coming years. "We have county-wide facilities. It's a matter of working together to create and

coordinate programs. It will require the cooperation of the county and the three county school boards."

And the biggest problem facing the county, according to Hinnant's viewpoint, is emergency ambulance service.

"I don't see how we can make everybody happy in this matter," he said. "And I don't think the other volunteer units can survive off proceeds from hot dog sales. They are going to need county subsidies to continue operations."
