You'll be delightfully surprised with the stage presentation of "The Sound of Music," playing through July 2 at Pineville Dinner Threatre, near Charlotte.

I have seen the movie at least four times and always think of Julie Andrews as Maria Rainer Von Trap swooping over the hills as the un-forgettable music swells in the background.

The stage at Pineville, is of course, smaller than that of the original Broadway production but the same ingredients that made the Broadway play and movie a hit make Pineville's: superb direction by Michael Heaton, a professional troupe of children with strong voices plus the strong voices of the show stars, Jacqueline Reilly as Maria, who incidentially

on the part of the director who takes the audience's eye off the changes by invoking heavenly in-tervention. The scenes move fast and the show approximates about two and one-half hours with the opening scene the longest at 80 minutes.


