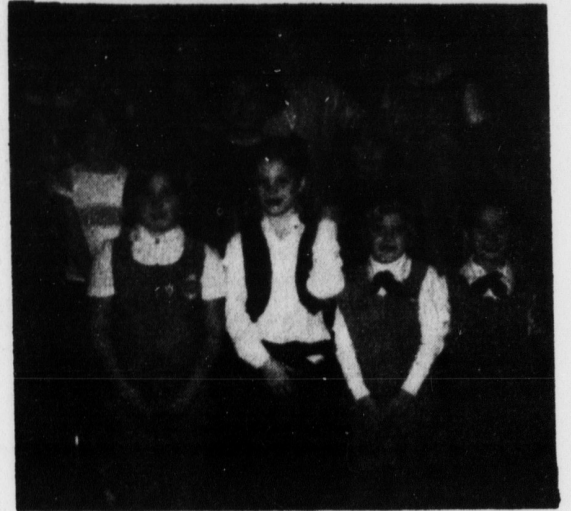
DONNA ELIZABETH MCGINNIS
