

2 tablespoons lemon juice 1/2 bottle Gerto fruit pectin

Crush berries, about one quart. Measure 1% cups into large bowl; add sugar, mix well.

Mix lemon juice and Certo in a bowl. Stir together, then pour into berries and sugar. Continue to stir 3 minutes. Pour into jars and cover with tight lids. Allow to set at room temperature for 24 hours. Then store in freezer. (For use within 8 weeks, may be stored in the refrigerator.

-000-SUPER STRAWBERRY CAKE 1 box white cake mix 3 teaspoons cake flour 1 box strawberry jello

% cup strawberries

1/2 cup water 1 cup Wesson oil 4 eggs

Put cake mix in large bowl. Add thick. Remove from heat and after flour and jello. Mix well. In another cooled fold in two cups sliced bowl put strawberries, water and oil. Stir to blend well. Pour all at Place in baked pie shell and put in once over dry ingredients. Mix at refrigerator until cold. Top with medium speed, add eggs one at a whipped cream or Dream Whip. time. Bake at 350 degrees 35 minutes.




