

Major Committees Named, At Work

Mayor John Moss has announced the appointment of several committees this week to handle preliminary planning in three important areas.

Humes Houston, district two commissioner, will chair the city's perimeter planning committee. Other members include Commissioners Corbet

Nicholson and James Childers.

This committee is charged with meeting with Gaston County planners and residents of Canterbury Rd. to discuss the future use of that property lying directly east of the city limits. The property actually lies in Gaston County, but falls within the

city's one-mile perimeter.

This property was rezoned for Light Industrial use in 1966 and since that time there have been some pockets rezoned for Heavy Industry. Residents of Canterbury Rd. appeared before the

board several months ago to request such a planning committee be established to discuss the use of the land.

The second committee named will be chaired by Commissioner Norman King and members are

Mayor Moss, vice-chairman, Commissioners Childers and Nicholson. This committee will conduct a feasibility study on the potential of the water line serving the southeastern section of the county and make a

recommendation on the feasibility of the city offering to purchase the line from the Cleveland County Development Corp.

This county government corporation was formed to raise financing to construct the lines from Kings

Mountain to serve residents southeast and Eaton Corp.

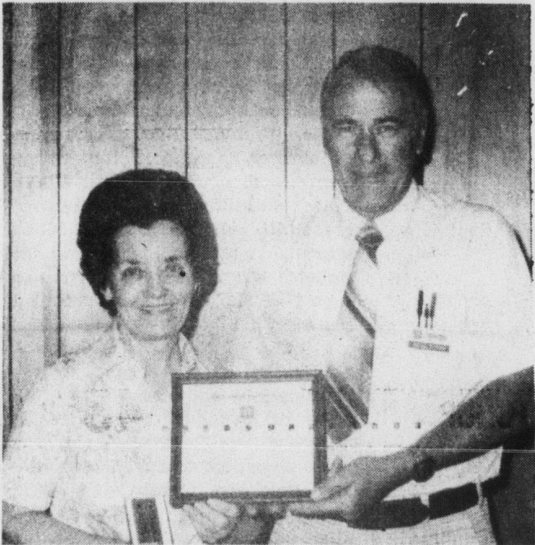
The third committee is chaired by Commissioner James Dickey and includes Commissioners William Grissom and Houston as members with

Mayor Moss as ex-officio member.

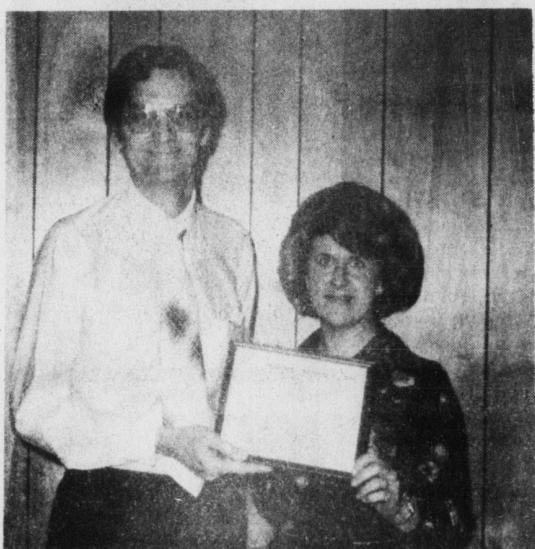
This committee will begin negotiations with the Town of Grover concerning Kings Mountain's treatment of the sister-community's domestic waste.

New Industry Coming

Acme-Cleveland Corporation has taken an option to purchase a parcel of approximately 30 acres of land in Shelby, according to an announcement today by W. Paul Cooper, President and Chief Executive Officer.

This will be the site of a new Acme-Cleveland Manufacturing Center which will utilize advanced equipment and methods to produce parts and product components for several Acme-Cleveland divisions. Plans call for the start of construction of the 38,400 square foot plant in July of this year with operations to begin early in 1980.

Thomas M. Sanders has been appointed Manager of the new facility. Sanders

joined Acme-Cleveland in 1975 as an Industrial Engineer with Shalco Systems Division's Kewanee Plant and was promoted to Manager of Manufacturing Services, Shalco-Kewanee in 1978. Prior to his new assignment he has held positions with Acme-Cleveland Development Company as Senior Manufacturing and Development Engineer and Coordinator, Assembly Process Development. Sanders holds a Bachelor of Science Degree from Iowa State University and is studying for a Master's Degree in Business Administration.

In his new assignment, Sanders will report to John R. Lenox, Machine Center Program Manager.
