Mrs. E.W. Neal entertained at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Jacob Cooper, on North Piedmont Ave.

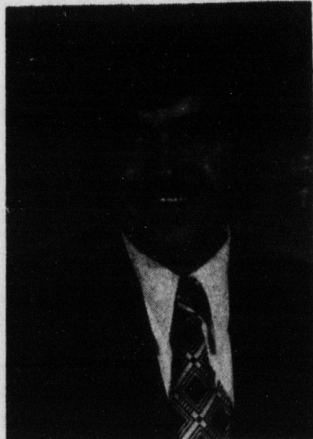
Present as visitors were Mrs. W.K. Cypok and Miss Elizabeth Anthony.
