

Complain To City Board

Citizens Want Leash Law

GROVER—Some citizens of Grover are in favor of a leash law. Residents, who aired their complaints of dogs scattering garbage and being a "nuisance", asked the board of commissioners Monday to seek the town attorney's advice on a town leash law.

Mayor W.W. McCarter said there is presently no ordinance on the town books and citizens at the

meeting, including Lee and Juanita Pruette, maintain that the county dog warden will not come unless those complaining catch the dogs and hold them until he drives to Grover from Shelby.

"We could be holding dogs all day", they maintained.

Another lady at the meeting suggested stray dogs be "poisoned, shot or made so sick they'd stop

bothering us" but Mayor McCarter and Chief Lionel Barnes won't recommend the stronger action.

Police Chief Barnes said the only way the town can enforce a dog ordinance is to have a leash law. In the meantime, if dogs are destroying property, property owners can take out a warrant on the dog's owner, charging him with destruction of personal property.
