Lineberger Adds CFC Scholarship

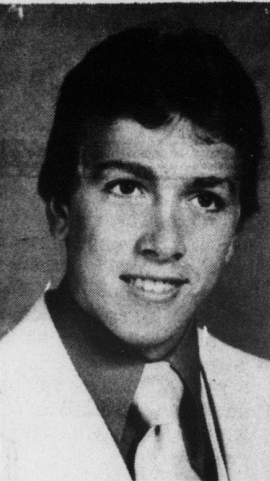
Barry Lineberger, a senior at Kings Mountain Senior High School, has received \$2,300 in scholarships from four different foundations.

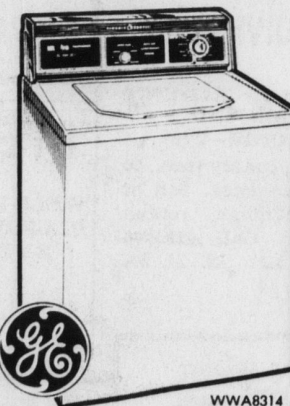

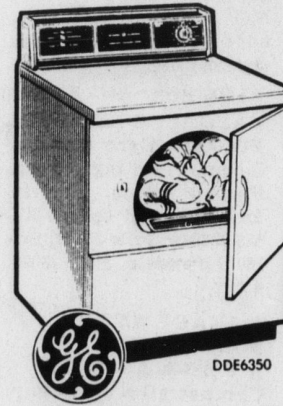

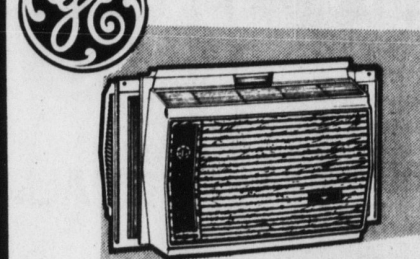
