

KM Students In Program

High school students from across North Carolina were on the campus of North Carolina State University last week getting an introduction to engineering programs at the university through the School of Engineering's Student Introduction to Engineering (SITE) program.

The program has brought approximately 400 rising high school sophomores, juniors and seniors to the campus since the middle of June. It is sponsored by the engineering school's Undergraduate Student Services Division.

The week-long workshop sessions included demonstration classes, laboratory projects, interaction with engineering students and faculty, and informal campus living and learning experiences.

Engineering fields covered in the program are mechanical, aerospace, electrical, civil, industrial, materials and chemical.

Byard Houck, director of the engineering school's special programs, is in charge of the SITE summer program. Assisting him as program coordinator is Cheryl Groves of Rockingham, an elec-

trical engineering senior.
