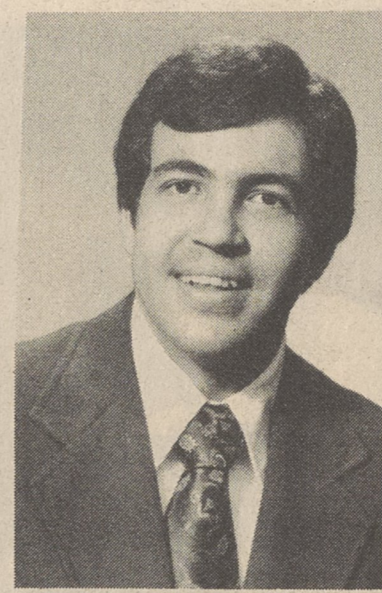
ARP Church Homecoming

Up-date on sports injuries

I'd recommend a simple code word for treatment of most minor sports injuries. Just remember the word RICE. R stands for rest; I, for ice; C, for compression; and E stands for elevation.

Play it safe when injured. If pain, swelling, immobility, laceration, or infection doesn't abate reasonably soon, consult your doctor.

Remember your pharmacy, too, when such foot-injury products as blister, callus, and corn pads, arch supports, and heel cushions are needed. Also, strains, sprains, bruises, and tendonitis should be treated first with cold, then with heat 24-hours later.
